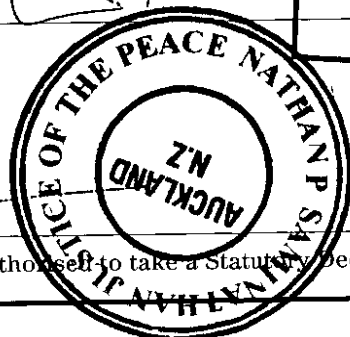
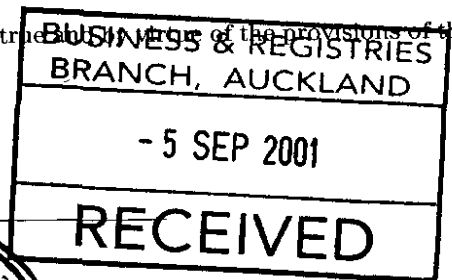

APPLICANTS

The application for incorporation must be made by a minimum number of 15 persons who are members of the society. A member of the society must be either a natural person or a corporate body.

If all or some of the members are corporate bodies, eg a company, another incorporated society, or a charitable trust, then each corporate body counts as three persons for the purpose of making up the minimum number of 15.

An unincorporated body (because it is not a legal person) cannot become a member of an incorporated society.

The application must be signed by the 15 applicant members. If they are individuals they should include their full names, occupations, and their residential addresses. A corporate body should sign in the way specified in its own rules or by statute for the execution of documents. This may be under common seal or may be by an authorised agent.

WITNESSES

Each applicant's signature must be witnessed and the witness must add his/her full name and residential address. One person can witness all the signatures, either individually or by bracketing all fifteen together and adding their signature, address and occupation only once.

A witness does not have to be a solicitor or Justice of the Peace. A witness can be another member of the society, but **MUST NOT** be one of the members who has signed as an applicant.

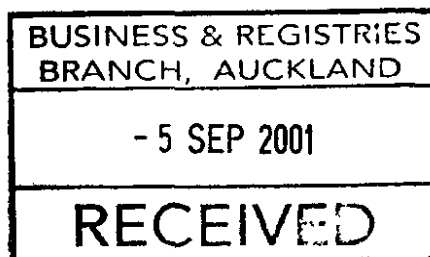

MUTHTAMIL SANGAM INCORPORATED CONSTITUTION

1. NAME:

The name of the association is “**Muth Tamil sangam**” incorporated (hereinafter called The “Association”)

2. OBJECTS:

- a To promote social contact, mutual helpfulness and recreation between persons of Tamil speaking , their spouses and families
- b To provide a support base for newly arrived Tamil immigrants to New Zealand
- c To provide a regular newsletter detailing association information and any other data considered of interest to association members
- d To conduct all religious functions

3. MEMBERSHIP:

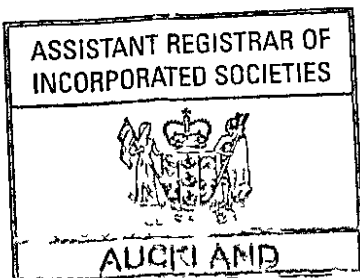
- a Membership shall be open to all persons over 18 (Eighteen) years of age , from India, Malaysia, Singapore and south Africa origins , their spouses and their families
- b Application for membership shall be in writing
- c Commencement of membership shall be upon payment of membership fee to the treasurer or in his absence otherwise authorized officer of the association
- d Termination of membership Membership may be terminated by ,
 - 1 Death
 - 2 Resignation (written)
 - 3 Resolution of management committee if any subscription remains unpaid for period of 1 month beyond the due date

4. PATRON:

The association may invite any individual(s) to be patron(s) of the association

5. SUBSCRIPTION:

- a The rate of subscription shall be fixed by the members at the annual general or special meeting
- b The subscription shall be payable by the 1st April of each year



6. EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE

- a An executive committee shall be elected consisting of president, vice president, secretary, treasurer and not more than 6 committee members
- b No person shall be entitled to serve as president, vice president, secretary or treasurer for more than 2 consecutive terms
- c All officers except the president and secretary shall hold office until the next ensuing Annual general meeting of the Association provided that the committee of the association may appoint a member to fill a vacancy in their number Any such member appointed to be confirmed at the next general meeting

7. MANAGEMENT OF ASSOCIATION

- a Executive committee shall meet regularly to carry on the business of the association
- b The record of the proceedings of each committee meeting shall be kept
- c The six members shall be form quorum at the any committee meeting
- d Ordinary meeting of committee shall be called by secretary at monthly or 2 month interval The meetings of committee the order of business shall be
 - 1 Apologize
 - 2 Confirmation of minutes
 - 3 Business arising from minutes
 - 4 Treasurer Report
 - 5 General Business
- e At all meetings the president shall preside, in his/her absence the vice president shall preside or in both absence , those present shall appoint one of their member to preside
- f The member of executive committee or any sub committee appointed by it, shall lose his/her seat if he/she fails to attend 3 consecutive meeting without leave or absence
- g Seven days notice shall be given for executive committee meetings
- h The executive committee shall have the power to appoint sub committees to be responsible for such areas of the associations activities as it shall decide
- i The secretary shall file with the registrar of the incorporated societies within 30days after the annual general meeting, the financial statement required to be filed under section 23 of the incorporated societies Act 1908

8. FINANCE

- a The association financial year shall commence on the first day of April each year and end on the Thirty first day of March in the same year
- b The trustee of the Association's bank account shall be the treasurer, President and one other committee member to be elected by the committee For signing



- of the cheques or any withdrawals from the association bank account s the signature of the treasurer plus one of other 2 trustees will be required
- c All the moneys of the association shall be paid in to bank Account
 - d All the payments shall be by cheques
 - e For the association to borrow money for the objects of the association, the approval of the two third majority of the votes cast at a general meeting shall be required

9. MEETINGS

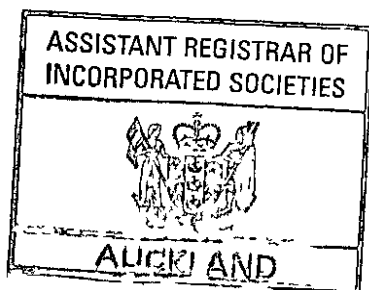
a Annual general meeting

They shall be held once in each year at a time and place to be fixed by the executive committee

- 1 The notice of the annual general meeting is forwarded to every member at their last notified address in writing not less than 7 days (or such other minimum period as the executive committee shall prescribe)
- 2 Any general meeting the attendants of 10 members shall form quorum
- 3 Such a meeting held by the following purposes
 - To read the minutes of previous general meeting , to receive annual reports, Balance Sheet and statement of Accounts, duly audited for the preceding year and adopt the same
 - To elect of the officers of the association
 - To decide on any motion which may be submitted to the meeting provided that such motions shall have been first submitted in writing to the executive committee at least 7 working days before the date of annual general meeting
 - To appoint an auditor for auditing by the committee
 - To set rate of annual subscription
- 4 Special general meeting of the association may be called as follows
 - By the resolution of the executive committee
 - Upon a request signed by 15 fully paid up financial members specifying the object thereof , delivered to the secretary

10.VOTING

- a Every paid member shall have one vote and voting by proxy will not be permitted



11. STANDING ORDERS:

The following shall be the standing orders of the Association

- a On all questions concerning these standing orders or points of order the chairperson's ruling shall be final provided that it shall be competent for any such member to move that the meeting disagree with such ruling shall be final provided that it shall be competent for any such member to move that the meeting with such ruling, which being seconded shall be put to the meeting without further discussion
- b No motion shall be discussed before it has been proposed and seconded.
- c Any member, excepting the mover and seconded of any motion under discussion may move an amendment thereto and on being seconded such amendment shall be open for discussion
- d No further amendment shall be received by the chairperson until the amendment before the meeting is dealt with
- e Amendments must be dealt with before the substantive motion
- f On all motions of questions before the meeting each member may speak once except the mover of the motion who alone shall have the right of reply, provided that the chairperson may use his/her discretion upon special applications for the right to speak twice to a motion
- g All questions shall be addressed to the chair
- h In addition to his/her deliberate vote, in event of equality of voting the chairperson may exercise a casting vote
- i No subject which has been negated or passed at any meeting shall be brought up for discussion except by notice of motion of which seven (7) days notice to members must be given

12. INCORPORATION

The Association shall be registered under the provisions of "The Incorporated Societies Act 1908"

13 SEAL

- a The common seal of the Association shall be kept in the Association of the secretary. Instruments to which the seal of Association is affixed shall be sufficiently executed on behalf of the Association if the seal is affixed in the presence of the president and the secretary and then only in pursuance of the resolution of the management committee

14 INTERPRETATION OF RULES

If any doubt shall arise to the proper meaning of any of these rules the decision of the executive committee thereon shall be final and conclusive, provided such



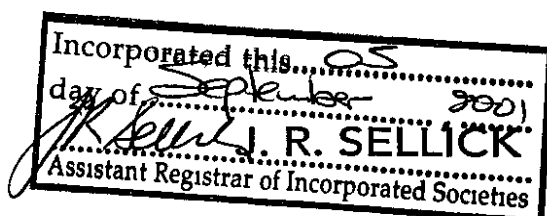
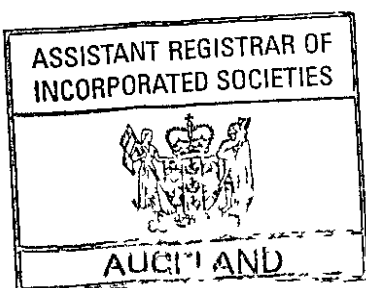
decision is reduced to writing and recorded on the minutes of the proceedings of the meeting

15. ALTERATIONS OF CONSTITUTION

Any of these rules can be altered or added by resolution passed by any annual or special general meeting by a two thirds majority of the members present at such meetings, provided that notice of the intention to propose such resolution shall, have been given in writing to all members and such resolution shall be approved by registered as provided in section 21 of the incorporated societies Act 1908

16. DISSOLUTION

- a The association may be voluntarily wound up if the association at a general meeting of its members passed a resolution requiring the association so to be wound up and the resolution is confirmed at a subsequent general meeting called together for that purpose and held not earlier than thirty(30) days after that date on which the resolution so to be confirmed was passed
- b In the event of the association being wound up, any surplus after payment of all liabilities shall be disposed of in such a manner as the persons who comprise the management committee at that date of such winding up shall by resolution determine. In the event of there being insufficient funds to meet all liabilities, the management committee shall be empowered to make levy on members of any amount not exceeding the last year's annual subscription
